CONTEST RULES:

1. Design a poster:

- not to exceed 14" x 17" in size,
- with an African-American theme,
- **MUST BE** centered around NAAPID (National African American Parent Involvement Day),
- the initials NAAPID **must** clearly appear on the poster.
- must clearly illustrate parent involvement in school.
- 2. The drawing may portray historical events or individuals, but it must clearly illustrate parent involvement in the student's school.
- 3. The contest is open to all K-12 students in the Washtenaw Intermediate School District (WISD). This is a student project and should reflect the student's own creative work.
- 4. All entries for judging must be received by 3:00 p.m. on Friday, January 21, 2011.
- 5. Six division prizes will be awarded:
 - kindergarten
 - lower elementary (grades 1-3)
 - upper elementary (grades 4-5)
 - special needs
 - middle school (grades 6-8)
 - high school (grades 9-12)
- 6. The winner in each division will receive a savings bond as indicated:
 - kindergarten \$50
 - lower elementary school \$100
 - upper elementary school \$100
 - special needs \$ based on grade level
 - middle school \$150
 - high school \$200

The savings bond will be mailed directly to each winning student's home 4 to 6 weeks after the program.



 The winning students will be formally introduced during the NAAPID at Night program on Monday, February 14, 2011 -5:30 p.m. at Saline High School Center for Performing Arts. Each winner will receive a certificate; a photo will be taken of the winning posters, the students and their families.

The winning posters will also be used to market the NAAPID 2012 at Night program. Parents will be expected to sign a letter of authorization.

8. The following information **must** be printed clearly on the back of the poster:

<u>Student information</u>: name, age, name of parents/guardians, home address, telephone number and e-mail address. <u>School information</u>: school, teacher's name, school address, telephone number and e-mail address.
